

More Coding with Flags

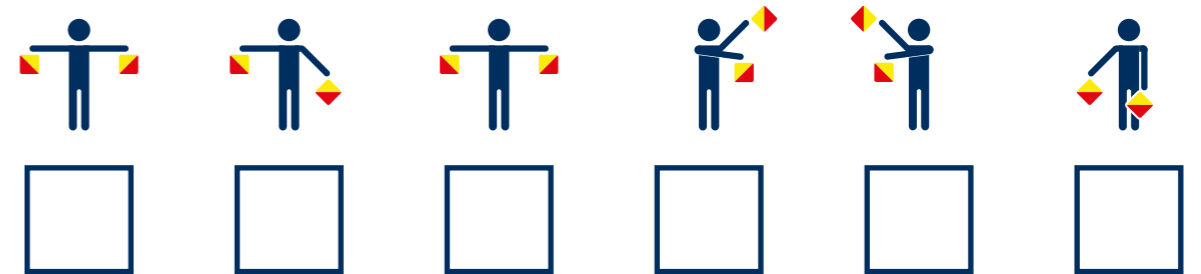
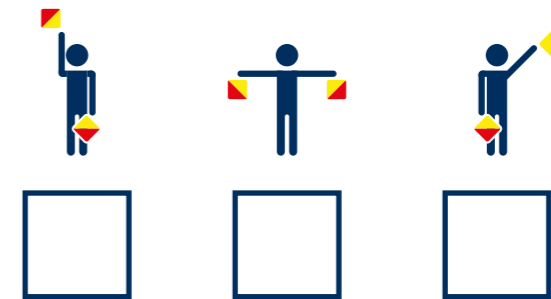


Here is a challenge for us. Let us try to complete this semaphore activity. You will need to look back at the semaphore codes we learnt before.

If you remember, we learned that semaphore is a system of sending messages by holding the arms, two flags or poles in certain positions to represent different letters of the alphabet. It is really useful if you want to send a message to someone who can see you but can't hear you.

This activity is a little bit trickier than the one we did before. All the letters here will spell out two words that are something to do with the Royal Air Force, but...they are all in the wrong places!

Can you work out what each letter is then rearrange them to tell me what the answer is?
